Misty,

To summarize let me make the following statements:

Based on my review of the history, neither Mr. Kibler nor any other employee of Bojangles' had contact with Mr. Caddell, nor do we believe was any message or indirect communication made by an employee of Bojangles' with Mr. Caddell or between Bojangles' and Mr. Caddell or any other council member.

David Atkins, a broker representing Bojangles' has given me a statement regarding his contacts with the County as follows:

"My discussions related to Bojangles' interest in purchasing a site in Carthage from Moore County have been directly with Cary McSwain, County Manager. In addition to multiple telephone discussions with Cary, we had one personal meeting in Carthage and Wayne Vest, tax administrator for Moore County joined us. I have not spoken to or communicated with any Moore County elected officials regarding this matter."

Bojangles' received a message from Chuck Spelman expressing displeasure regarding Bojangles' interest in the site owned by the city (my paraphrase), and asking for someone to contact him from the Company. Mr. Kibler then called him on June 16, 2012, and in the course of that conversation pointed out the long history Bojangles' has of supporting veterans' groups, and offered to send him a list of such activities. Also, in that conversation, Mr. Kibler expressed that we were not going to proceed until the County resolved its issues. Mr. Kibler immediately instructed the real estate department to take no further action to pursue the parcel adjacent to the memorial. It is our understanding that, of course, the County is not at this time taking further steps regarding this property, which was communicated to Mr. Atkins, the broker. Therefore, the current status of the matter appears to be that neither the County nor Bojangles' is actively pursuing the sale of the parcel and have not done so since at least June 16, 2012.

We believe Bojangles' has been misrepresented in various ways as shown in press and commentary and statements by various parties, and we would like to state that any statement or inference by any party that Bojangles' has been involved in any action or contact except through ordinary commercial channels with the authorized professional managers of the County in a wholly transparent manner, is entirely false and perhaps libelous.
