As we look ahead to the primary on Tuesday, we again focused our attention on critiquing Kay Hagan's liberal record and support of Obamacare.

There was quite a bit of bad news for Hagan this week. A new Elon Poll released yesterday shows Hagan's approval rating is only 35 percent, with 47 percent disapproving. The New York Times wrote about how the voter turnout drop for

Democrats this year could be higher in North Carolina than in any other state, meaning that Hagan might actually be in worse shape than it would appear.
