

**Resolution on Congressional Vote Confirming Electoral College
Results on Jan 6, 2021**

Whereas: There is mounting evidence that extensive election fraud occurred in Pennsylvania, Georgia, Wisconsin, Michigan, Arizona and Nevada.

Whereas: Confirming the electoral college results in those states will negate the legitimate votes of the citizens in North Carolina that re-elected Donald J. Trump as President.


Whereas: The legitimacy of future elections is threatened if the aforementioned states' results are allowed to stand without a thorough review.


Whereas: The integrity of the election process and the confidence of the people in that process are essential to the survival of the Republic.


Whereas: Republican Party members need to have confidence that the party will assert and defend their rights as far as is possible under law.

Whereas: The United States Constitution allows individual representatives and senators to refuse to endorse the results of elections from other states.

Be it Resolved: That the Third District of the Republican Party of North Carolina calls upon all our Republican Representatives and our two Republican Senators to reject the electors from the six aforementioned states when the Electoral College reports are presented in a joint Session of Congress on January 6, 2021.
