

Resolution of Concern –Senator Thom Tillis

Whereas Countless GOP volunteers put in countless hours and generous donations to help elect Thom Tillis to the U.S. Senate in 2014, expecting his voting proclivities and behaviors would faithfully and consistently represent conservative NCGOP and RNC values; and

Whereas, even before Donald J. Trump was inaugurated as President of the United States, Senator Tillis published a letter in the Charlotte Observer claiming the election of Mr. Trump did not represent a mandate for a "far right" agenda, intimating the senator would work with democrats on compromise solutions that conservatives might find objectionable; and

Whereas, during a live television interview with Tucker Carlson in April 2017, Senator Tillis clearly downplayed the need for a border wall on the U.S. southern border in opposition to the campaign pledge of our President; and

Whereas, in July 2017 Senator Tillis placed a hold on the appointment of Lee Francis Cisna as Director of the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services, holding this appointment hostage until the Trump Administration provided more H2B visas; and


Whereas, in August 2017 Senator Tillis co-sponsored the Special Prosecutor Integrity Act, that would have usurped DOJ authority and clearly served as a threat to our President and his staff.

Therefore, be it resolved, the Executive Committee of the NCGOP 6th Congressional District is disappointed in the behavior, media interviews and public statements made by Senator Tillis.

Be it further resolved, the behavior of Senator Tillis has shaken the confidence of the 6th Congressional District in our elected junior U.S. Senator from North Carolina.


